****CAMPING NOTES****

Camping is accessible. Please take precautions and watch for hazardous trees. Concessionaire is working on removing the hazardous trees. Be aware of wet conditions and where you drive to prevent resource damage.

Please note that because of the pine beetle problem, please look up and around before deciding on a spot to camp. Campgrounds that are accessible will be cleared of obvious hazards trees, but strong winds have toppled both dead and live trees on the district.

The Stateline dump station is closed. Could be working by the weekend.

RECREATION RESERVATIONS

The National Recreation Reservation Service takes reservations for most campgrounds up to 180 days in advance at **1-877-444-6777** or on the Internet at www.recreation.gov. These sites can be reserved no less than 5 days in advance. Reservations are for Mid-May thru Labor Day only.

ROADS

There is no longer winter maintenance on Stateline Dam Road. You can access Henry's Fork through Lonetree, WY within a mile or two of the trailhead.

TRAILS

Trails and trailheads still have snow. Please remember to TREAD LIGHTLY. Check motor vehicle use maps (MVUM's) for restrictions. Snow level is around 9500 feet. Still snow in the Wilderness and muddy in lower elevations.
