### \*\*CAMPING NOTES\*\*

Please note that because of the pine beetle problem, please look up and around before deciding on a spot to camp. Campgrounds that are accessible are being cleared of obvious hazards trees, but strong winds have toppled both dead and live trees on the district.

\*The campground hosts are gone, but the campgrounds listed above are still accessible. They are pack in/pack out, no water available. If the campgrounds are along the Mirror Lake Highway, please purchase a pass to stay in the campgrounds. It is recommended that you bring your own toilet paper as the vault toilets aren't checked as often as they are when the hosts are there.

**The Lily Lake dump and water station is closed for the season.**

## RECREATION RESERVATIONS

The National Recreation Reservation Service takes reservations for most campgrounds up to 180 days in advance at **1-877-444-6777** or on the Internet at [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov). These sites can be reserved no less than 5 days in advance. Reservations are for Mid-May thru Labor Day only.
