CAMPING NOTES

Please note that because of the pine beetle problem, please look up and around before deciding on a spot to camp. Campgrounds that are accessible will be cleared of obvious hazards trees when crews arrive in late May, but strong winds have toppled both dead and live trees on the district.

The Lily Lake dump and water station is open. One side is closed down until we can get it fixed.

RECREATION RESERVATIONS

The National Recreation Reservation Service takes reservations for most campgrounds up to 180 days in advance at 1-877-444-6777 or on the Internet at www.recreation.gov. These sites can be reserved no less than 5 days in advance. Reservations are for June 18 to September 6 only.

Bear River Ranger Station is open with window service. Hours are Thursday – Monday 8-4:30.

Bear River can only accept cash or check for payment.

There are 6 yurts: Bear Claw, East Fork, Lily Lake, Ridge, Beulah Vista and Boundary Creek available for rent. Boundary Creek is a primitive experience; the trail from the Ridge Yurt to the Boundary Creek Yurt is non-motorized.

FIREWOOD/TEEPEE POLE PERMITS –

Permits are currently available for purchase at the Evanston Office or the Bear River Station. Post and Pole permits are only available at the Evanston office. **Bear River only accepts cash or check for payment.**

Stage 1 Fire Restriction

Fire restrictions are currently in effect for the UWCNF, starting June 18th, 2021 at 00:01 a.m. to September 30, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (36 CRF 264.50(a) and (b); Forest Order # 04-19-491).
