Temporary Closure on Hallowat Creek North Road

Crews Working to Remove Large Slump

HUNGRY HORSE, MT. – The Hallowat Creek North Road, Forest Road #315, located in the North Fork area on the Hungry Horse/Glacier View Ranger District, will be closed to public use beginning May 21, 2012. The road is anticipated to remain closed for approximately 10 days. The closure is at the Hallowat pit (Junction of Forest Road 316 and 315.) This road provides access to Moose Lake.

Spring weather conditions with rapidly warming temperatures and snowmelt caused an impassible road slump. Crews will be working to remove mud and debris from the road, ensure proper drainage, and allow saturated soils to dry.

Anyone with information about other road damage or any unsafe conditions on the Flathead National Forest is asked to contact a local forest service office.
