- Sponsored an Integral Youth Services Crew who sanded and painted all picnic tables and signs, and cleared vegetation along trails in Williamson River Campground.

### Special Feature

Bordering Crater Lake National Park on the south, Sky Lakes Wilderness is a land of crystalline sub-alpine lakes, rocky ridges, and forested slopes. Mt. McLoughlin, the highest point in the Wilderness, offers an incredible view of southern Oregon. Its three larger lakes are popular fishing and camping destinations, though opportunities for solitude can be found by those willing to take the less traveled path.
