**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
PLEASANT GROVE RANGER DISTRICT**

DAY USE, TRAILHEAD AND PICNIC AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following act is prohibited** in day use, picnic areas and trailheads as described in this order, all within the Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect until further notice.

1. **Going into or being in Echo, Roadhouse, Martin, and Mile Rock Picnic sites when posted, gated or marked as closed as described below, Tuesday June 12, 2012 through Wednesday June 13, 2012** [36 CFR 261.53(e)] [36 CFR 261.58(b)]
2. **Going into or being in Tibble Fork Trailhead when posted, gated or marked as closed as described below, Tuesday, June 12, 2012 through Wednesday, June 13, 2012.** [36 CFR 261.53(e)] [36 CFR 261.55(b)]
3. **Going into or being in Sawmill and Grey Cliffs Picnic sites when posted, gated or marked as closed as described below, Wednesday June 13, 2012 through June 14, 2012.** [36 CFR 261.53(e)] [36 CFR 261.58(b)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Echo, Roadhouse, Martin and Mile Rock Picnic sites and Tibble Fork Trailhead all located in Township 4 South, Range 3 East, Sections 7, 18, 19 and Township 4 South, Range 2 East Section 24 all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian. See attached map.

Sawmill and Grey Cliff picnic sites located in Township 4 South, Range 2 East, Sections 24 and 25 all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian. See attached map.


PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety while heavy equipment and crews are micro-surfacing along Utah State Route 92 from Pine Hollow Trailhead to the mouth of American Fork Canyon and all of Utah State Route 144 known as the North Fork Road.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
