

Fire Restrictions 6/01/2012

Stage 1 fire restrictions are in place on the following lands. Please review the specific order for detailed description of banned practices and activities that are allowed.

Stage I Restricted activities may vary by agency/jurisdiction. Restrictions on the Gunnison Ranger District are:

- 1) Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, coal- or wood-burning stove fire, any type of charcoal-fueled broiler or open fire of any type [36 CFR 261.52(a), 43 CFR 9212.2(a)].

EXCEPT: Fires are allowed in constructed, permanent fire pits or fire grates within recreation sites and petroleum-fueled stoves, lanterns, or heating devices that meet the fire underwriters' specifications for safety. Fires that are maintained or attended within a device that has a spark arrestor or where the fire is fully enclosed within a screen at all times are allowed.

2) Smoking [36 CFR 261.52(d), 43 CFR 9212.2(a)].

EXCEPT: within an enclosed vehicle or building, in a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least 3 feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material.

3) Operating or using any internal combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order meeting either:

a. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service Standard 5100-1a; or

b. Appropriate Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) recommended practice J335 (b) and J350 (a). 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(j).


