Type II Incident Management Team Assumes Command of Cow Camp Fire

Key Facts

- Rocky Mountain Incident Management Team C, a Type II team, assumed command of the fire this morning at 6 a.m.
- Fire size is now estimated at 6,066 acres, based on infrared mapping last night, and containment is 10%
- Smoke will be visible in the area today, including on I-25 and in Wheatland, WY
- Thursday's weather forecast is favorable for fire crews....cloudy, cooler, higher humidity
- Winds are expected to be S/SE and thunderstorms are possible today
- A Structure Protection Plan is in place for Camp Grace, which is NE of the fire

Wheatland, WY –

Command of the Cow Camp Fire in North Albany County, WY, transitioned to Rocky Mountain Incident Management Team C with Joe Lowe as the Incident Commander, on Thursday morning.

“Much of the credit for where we are today is due to the hard work of the Type III team,” said Joe Lowe, Incident Commander on the event. “We will continue to move in that direction.”

Fire behavior is still active and has moved in a variety of directions over rugged terrain.

A thunderstorm with heavy rains moved through Southeast Wyoming on Wednesday night, but moved just south of the fire and had little impact.
