

Forest Order No. 10-12-04
SIX RIVERS NATIONAL FOREST
Horse Mountain Mine and Mill Area and Road Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Lower Trinity Ranger District of the Six Rivers National Forest. This Order is effective from June 12, 2012 through June 11, 2014.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Horse Mountain Mine and Mill Closure Area. The boundary of the Horse Mountain Mine and Mill Area and Road Closure begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 6N01 and Forest Road No. 06N36, then continues north along the eastern shoulder of Forest Road No. 06N36 to the northern boundary of Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 4 East, Humboldt Meridian, then continues east along the boundary line of Section 33 to its intersection with Horse Mountain Creek, then continues southeast along the creek to the eastern boundary of Section 34, then continues south along the eastern boundary of Section 34 to the southern boundary of Township 6 North, then continues west along the southern boundary of Township 6 North to its intersection with Forest Road No. 06N01, then continues north along the eastern shoulder of Forest Road No. 6N01 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 216.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Horse Mountain Mine and Mill Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Contractors engaged in operations authorized by the Forest Service within the Horse Mountain Mine and Mill Closure Area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
