AREA CLOSURE: All campgrounds, roads, and trails between Murdock Basin (Forest Service Road #137) and the Highline Trail along the south and east side of Highway 150 is closed to all camping, hiking, and vehicle use due to the Mirror Lake Complex Fire.

STRAWBERRY VISITOR CENTER

The Strawberry Visitor Center is open from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Closes for the season on September 29.

SOAPSTONE SANITATION STATION

The Soapstone Sanitation Station is operational and requires a Mirror Lake Recreation Pass to fill with fresh water and/or dump gray or black water. Scheduled to close in early October.

SHEEP AND CATTLE

There are Open Range areas on our district where sheep and cattle may be encountered.

MIRROR LAKE RECREATION PASS

A Mirror Lake Recreation Pass or an Interagency Recreation Pass (America the Beautiful National Park Pass) is required for recreation at designated recreation fee sites within the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway fee area. A Recreation Pass is required for all vehicles parked at designated fee sites. Passes are available at the Heber-Kamas Ranger District Offices in Heber City and Kamas, Kamas Food Town, Chevron, and Samak Smoke House. Self-serve fee tubes are located along the Mirror Lake Highway at Slate Creek (mile marker 6.3), Soapstone Trailhead (mile marker 14.6), just below the Trial Lake turn off (mile marker 25), and Crystal Lake Trailhead. Cash or check only are accepted at these self-serve fee tubes.

CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Reservations can be made by contacting the National Recreation Reservation System (NRRS) up to 360 days in advance for group sites and 6 months in advance for individual sites by calling 1-877-444-6777 or on the internet at www.recreation.gov. Reservations must be made at least 5 days in advance for individual sites. All campgrounds that remain open after Labor Day are first-come first-serve (shows as “walk-up” on NRRS), Group sites and pavilions are by reservation only.

OFFICE LOCATIONS

The Heber Office is located about 1 mile outside of Heber on Highway 40 heading south on the way to Daniels Canyon and is open Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Kamas Office is located within the first block of Highway 150 in Kamas and serves as the west portal for the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway. The Kamas Office is open 7 days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
