## **RECREATION RESERVATIONS**

**Reservations can be made by contacting** the National Recreation Reservation System (NRRS) **and are available up to 360 days in advance for group sites and 6 months in advance for individual sites by calling 1-877-444-6777 or on the Internet at [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov).** Group sites and pavilions are by reservation only. Long Term sites are reserved through American Land and Leisure at 435-315-8453.

## **TRANSPLANT PERMITS**

Permits are now available at the Heber-Kamas Ranger District office. The cost per tree is \$6.00 for Sub Alpine Fir and \$4.00 for Aspen. The best time to transplant Aspen trees are while they are still dormant probably until the end of May. You can also do this in the fall once they become dormant again and before it gets too cold to dig them.

## **FUELWOOD & POST & POLE PERMITS**

Permits will go on sale beginning June 26<sup>th</sup>.through October 31<sup>st</sup>. They are \$7.50 a cord with a minimum of 4 cords and a maximum of 10 cords. Anything dead and down or dead and standing with the stipulation on the standing dead that if the tree is bigger than 18” in diameter at 4 ½ feet tall and it is a cone bearing tree it cannot be cut down. The area allowed for cutting is the Heber-Kamas Ranger District.

## **OFFICE LOCATION**

The Heber-Kamas Ranger District is located about 1 mile outside of Heber on the way to Daniels Canyon. The Kamas Work Center is located within the first block of Highway 150 in Kamas and serves as the west portal for the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway. Our office hours are 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. We are closed weekends and holidays.
