| FACTS Code | Treatment Name | Treatment Description | Objectives |
| Fire/Fuels Activities | | | |
| 1111 | Broadcast Burning – Covers the Majority of the Unit | Prescribed burning activity where fire is applied to the majority or all of an area within well-defined boundaries for reduction of fuel hazard, as a resource management treatment, or both. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 1112 | Jackpot Burning – Scattered Concentrations | Prescribed burning of fuels in scattered concentrations. Does not cover a majority of the unit | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 1113 | Under Burn – Low Intensity (Majority of Unit) | Prescribed burns of low intensity covering a majority of the burn unit consuming surface fuels, but not the overstory canopy. Ladder fuels can be consumed or scorched. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 1120 | Yarding – Removal of Fuels by Carrying or Dragging | Includes any activity that removes fuel from the site by carrying or dragging. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior |
| 1130 | Burning of Piled Material | Pile Burn. Burning of piled material including hand and machine piles and decks. | Alter Wildfire Behavior |
| 1136 | Pruning to Raise Canopy Height and Discourage Crown Fire | Fuels Pruning. Removal of live or dead branches from standing trees to raise the canopy base height and discourage initiation of crown fire. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior |
| 1140 | Fireline Construction | Part of a control line that is scraped or dug to mineral soil. | Alter Wildfire Behavior |
| 1150 | Rearrangement of Fuels | Any rearranging of fuels such as limbs, tops, or brush to reduce fuel bed depth or speed up decomposition. Includes slashing and lop and scatter. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 1153 | Piling of Fuels, Hand or Machine | Hand or machine piling of fuels. | Alter Wildfire Behavior |
| 1154 | Chipping of Fuels | Breaking down/or slicing of trees, changing the size or shape into smaller pieces. Includes leaving on site or removing. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 1160 | Thinning of Hazardous Fuels | Fuels Thinning. Selective felling of trees and shrubs for non-commercial hazardous fuels reduction purposes. | Alter Wildfire Behavior |

| 4111 | Patch Clearcut | A type of stand clearcutting where patches (or strips) are clearcut within an individual stand boundary. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4113 | Stand Clearcut | An even-aged regeneration or harvest method that removes all trees in the stand producing a fully exposed microclimate for the development of a new age class in one entry. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4115 | Patch Clearcut (w/ leave trees) | A type of stand clearcutting where patches (or strips) are clearcut within an individual stand boundary. A minor (less than approximately 10% of full stocking) live component may be retained for reasons other than regeneration. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4117 | Stand Clearcut (w/leave trees) | An even-aged regeneration or harvest method that removes most trees in the stand producing an exposed microclimate for the development of a new age class in one entry. A minor (less than approximately 10% of full stocking) live component is retained for reasons other than regeneration. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4132 | Seed-tree Seed Cut (with and without leave trees) | A type of cut that removes trees except those needed for the purposes of seed production. Prepares the seed bed and creates a new age class in an exposed microenvironment. Additional trees may be retained to provide a minor (less than approximately 10% of full stocking) live component after the removal cut, for reasons other than regeneration | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4210 | Improvement Cut | An intermediate harvest which removes the less desirable trees of any species in a stand of poles or larger trees, primarily to improve the composition and quality. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4220 | Commercial Thinning | An intermediate harvest with the objective of reducing stand density primarily to improve growth, enhance forest health, and other resources objectives. | 4242 | Harvest Without Restocking | The harvesting of trees from lands where the restocking of trees is not desired to meet desired vegetative conditions | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |

| 4453 | Initiate Natural Regeneration | The use of natural regeneration to establish a new age class from natural seeding, sprouting or suckering. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4455 | Slashing - Pre-Site Preparation | An activity (felling, bucking, lopping of trees) done to a site in advance of site preparation designed to enhance the success of the site preparation treatment. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4491 | Site Prep for Natural Regeneration - Burning | Manipulation of a site by prescribed burning to enhance the success of natural regeneration. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4494 | Site Preparation for Natural Regeneration - Mechanical | Manipulation of a site using mechanical methods to enhance the success of natural regeneration. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4411 | Tree Release and Weed | A treatment designed to free young trees from undesirable, competing vegetation. Includes cleaning and weeding which are done in stands not past sapling stage. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 4521 | Precommercial Thin | The cutting of trees not for immediate financial return but to reduce stocking. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior |

| 6101 | Wildlife Habitat Prescribed Fire | Prescribed burning or tree felling to remove conifer trees in a historical shrubland to enhance or improve wildlife habitat. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 6104 | Wildlife Habitat Regeneration Cut | Removal of all trees in the stand producing a fully exposed microclimate for the development of a new age class in one entry to enhance or improve wildlife habitat. | Forest Health/Forest Resiliency Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 2400 | Tree Encroachment Control | Prescribed burning and/or tree felling to remove conifer trees in a historical grassland setting to enhance/improve the non-forest setting. | Improve Rangeland Vegetation Alter Wildfire Behavior Maintain, Improve or Enhance Wildlife Habitat |
| 2510 | Pesticide Application | Use of pesticide application to control nonnative/ noxious weeds. | Treatment of Noxious Weeds |
