

FIRE

Stage 2 restrictions are in effect due to the extreme fire danger from prolonged hot and dry weather conditions.

RESTRICTIONS



PROHIBITED:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, charcoal, coal, wood or stove. *Exceptions:* Petroleum-fueled stoves, lanterns, propane grills, or heating devices are ok.
2. Smoking, except within a vehicle or building.
3. Using an explosive.
4. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun.
5. Possession, discharging or using any type of firework or pyrotechnic device.
6. Operating a chainsaw, or other equipment powered by an internal combustion engine, is prohibited from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
7. Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.
8. Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained, and in effective working order.
9. Driving a motor vehicle off National Forest System roads, except when parking in an area devoid of vegetation within 10 feet of the roadway; and except for parking overnight in Forest Service developed campgrounds and trailheads.
10. Violating any state law, concerning burning, fires, or which is for the purpose of preventing or restricting the spread of fire.
