The Cabin Thin Stewardship Integrated Resource Contract is located within T. 4 N. R. 4 E., Sections 24, 25 and 36, W.M., Surveyed, Clark County; T. 3 N., R. 5 E., Section 6, T. 4 N., R. 5 E., Sections 19, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, T. 4 N., R. 6 E., Section 30, T. 7 N., R. 4 E., Section 2, T. 7 N., R. 6 E., Section 32, T. 7 N., R. 7 E., Section 17, T. 8 N., R. 5 E., Sections 34 and 36, T. 8 N., R. 6 E., Sections 2, 4, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 29, 30, 31, and 32, T. 8 N., R. 7 E., Sections 5, 7, 8 and 18, W.M., Partially Surveyed, Skamania County, Washington. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Gifford Pinchot National Forest Headquarters, 10600 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Circle, Vancouver, WA 98682 no later than 10:00 AM local time on or before August 14, 2012 for an estimated volume of 6,956 CCF of Douglas-fir and 5,068 CCF of Western Hemlock and Other Coniferous Species sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the contract area an estimated volume of 440 CCF of All Species grn bio cv that the offeror agrees to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are three (3) restorative service projects. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the offeror (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below.
