


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Alternative 7R Management Prescriptions Existing Motorized Route Densities Allowable Motorized Route Densities



The numbers in black on the prescription polygons represent the current open motorized route density in the area. The numbers in blue that are below/beside the black numbers represent the allowable open motorized route density for the area. Numbers are in miles per square mile.



- *CHANGES IN THIS REVISED MAP**
This GIS layer, called alt7r_trav05, incorporates changes as a result of the Caribou Revised Travel Plan ROD and Forest Plan Amendments 1, 2 and 3. The net effects are:
- Slight changes to some Rx boundaries due to realignment of roads and trails over DOQs.
 - OMRD values are current per new Travel Plan.
 - Forest Plan Amendment 1.
 - No more cross country travel (previously allowed in Huckleberry area). Forest Plan Amendment 2.
 - New boundary for non-motorized polygon east of Pebble Cr Ski Area. Forest Plan Amendment 3.
 - Additional corrections applied on this GIS layer changed the mining disturbance polygons on the Elkhorn portion of Westside RD from 8.2.2 (phosphate mines) to 6.2 (Rangeland Mgt). These are perlite mines that were incorrectly coded as phosphate mines on the original Alt 7R maps.
