Bird Walk:

Join a naturalist-birder. Easy stroll. Meet at the Mono Lake County Park (5 miles north of Lee Vining just east of Hwy 395). 1½-2 hrs.

Stars Over Mono Lake:

Meet at South Tufa Kiosk. Bring something to sit on & dress warmly. (NPS)

South Tufa Walk:

Discover the mystery of Mono Lake's strange water. Meet at the South Tufa Kiosk. 5 miles east of Hwy 395 on Hwy 120. 1-1½ hrs.

"Help the Mono Basin's Fragile Stream Ecosystems Recover!"

Join a Mono Lake Committee naturalist to learn about creek restoration. Excursion in the field to pull invasive weeds or water Jeffrey Pine saplings. Short drive on some dates. Wear long pants, bring gloves if you have them & water. Snack provided. Meet at MBSA Visitor Center Patio. 2 hrs.

Panum Crater:

Explore the volcano's secrets. Meet at the Panum Crater parking lot. 1½ hrs.
Starts July 7th

Lundy Canyon Walk:

Guided walk on mining & natural history. Meet at Historical Marker at Lundy Resort. 1½ hrs.
