Alcoholic Beverage Restriction

Avery Creek Area – NFSR 477

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. Sections 261.50 (a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the following act is prohibited on the Pisgah Ranger District. Specifically the entire length of Forest System Road 477 (also known as Avery Creek Road), and 1,000 feet from either side of the roadway as indicated on the closure map. The order is effective from June 1, 2009 until June 1, 2014.

**Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by State law.  
[36 CFR 261.58 (bb)]**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Persons with a valid reservation occupying the White Pines Group Campgrounds (A) administered under permit from the Cradle of Forestry Interpretation Association.
3. Visitors of the Pisgah Stables (B) operating under permit from the National Forests in North Carolina.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.
