Closure of Grimshaw Mine

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C. Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. Sections 261.50 (a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the following act is prohibited at the Grimshaw Mine, on the Pisgah Ranger District Pisgah, of the Pisgah National Forest; as described on the attached map. This order is effective December 1, 2008, through December 1, 2013.


For public health and safety, it is prohibited to go into or be upon the area of Grimshaw Mine Site that is closed to public by signs and barricades. 36 CFR 261.53(a) and (e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.
