**Bear Cub Fire
Emergency Area Closure**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited within the following described area of the Teton Wilderness Area, all within the **BUFFALO Ranger District**, Bridger-Teton National Forest until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the fire area which is closed for the protection of public health or safety. See the attached map. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**
2. Being on a trail that is posted as closed. See the attached map **36 CFR 261.55(a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The area of the Teton Wilderness Area south of Trails 6051 and 6054; east of Trails 6047 and 6051s and north and west of the Wilderness boundary. Refer to attached map.

The above described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Buffalo Ranger District, Bridger-Teton National Forest, Teton and Fremont Counties, WY.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to protect public safety during suppression activities of the Bear Cub wildfire in the vicinity of the South Buffalo Fork River.


IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals, and \$10,000.00 for organizations

and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].

4. Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
