

Fifteen Mile Trail #456



Recreation Opportunity Guide

Distance..... 10.3 miles (one way)
Elevation..... 2400-4600 feet
Snow Free May to October



Trail Highlights: This well-travelled trail has a moderate grade and travels through pine oak forest with numerous rock outcroppings. At times the trail follows Fifteenmile Creek. **The attached map is not correct. Bonney Crossing Campground is not at this location and the trail actually begins at Eightmile Meadow. See trail description below.**

Trail Description: This trail begins at Eightmile Meadow and heads east to Fifteenmile Campground (4,600') and ends at Road 4421. Head northeast from Fifteenmile Campground, following Fifteenmile Creek, and travel 0.5 mile to the junction with Cedar Creek Trail #457. From the junction, continue heading north-northeast for 5.1 miles to the junction with Cedar Creek Trail #457. Continue east following Fifteenmile Creek for 3.3 miles to the end of this trail at Road 4421. Visitors can choose a loop by turning right (south) on Cedar Creek Trail #457 and following it 4.6 miles back to the junction with this trail (#456). To finish the loop, continue southwest to Fifteen Mile Campground.

Leave No Trace

- Plan Ahead and Prepare: Prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies.
- Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces: Use established trails and campsites.
- Dispose of Waste Properly: Pack out all trash, leftover food and litter.
- Leave What You Find: Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species.
- Minimize Campfire Impacts: Use established fire rings & keep fires small.
- Respect Wildlife: Control pets at all times.
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors: Avoid loud voices and noises.





Directions to Trailhead: From Hood River, take OR Hwy 35 south 26 miles, 0.15 mile past milepost 71, to Dufur Mill Road (Forest Road 44). Turn left (east) on Forest Road 44 and go 8 miles to Forest Road 4420. Turn right (south) and drive 2.1 miles on Forest Road 4420 to Forest Road 2730. Take the left fork and follow Forest Road 2730 for 2 miles to the Fifteen Mile Campground. The trail leaves from the campground.

From Dufur, go west on Dufur Mill Road and after 5.1 miles take the right fork to stay on Dufur Mill Road (Forest Road 44). Turn left (south) on Forest Road 4420 and follow the directions above.
