Emergency Closure of Badin Lake OHV Trails and  
Bates Horse Trail


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within portions of the Badin Lake Recreation Area, located on the Uwharrie National Forest. The area is identified on the attached map. This closure is in effect from October 1, 2007 until the order is officially terminated by the Forest Supervisor.

For public health and safety and for fire fighter safety, it is prohibited for the public to use the off-highway vehicle (OHV) trails (Wolfden, Slab Pile, Sawmill, Dutch John, Falls Dam, and a portion of Rocky Mountain Loop) and the Bates Horse trail in the Badin Lake Recreation Area. 36 CFR 261.53(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the authorized Forest Service Officer specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act or omission. This does not include the OHV permits that are sold to the public.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force working in the performance of an official duty.
