FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited as described below within the Seeley Lake Ranger District of the Lolo National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective upon signing and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.55 – National Forest System trails

It is prohibited to be on the trail. (36 CFR 261.55a).

The closure cited in this order is to provide for public safety during the Dunham Fire.

Description of Closed trail:

National Forest System Trail #246, Center Ridge trail (Monture Guard Station to Center Creek trail); Sections 7, 18, 19 and 20, T 16 N, R 12 W; Sections 18, 19, 30 and 31, T 17 N, R 12 W; Sections 1 and 12, T 16 N, R 13 W; Sections 11, 12, 13, 24 and 25, T 17 N, R 13W as shown on the attached map.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16USC 551 and 18USC 3559 and 3571).
