## Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee to Reconvene August 20 at the Klamath Forest Supervisor's Office

**YREKA, CA,**—On July 6, 2012, the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000 was reauthorized for one year as part of Public Law 112-141. As a result the Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) will reconvene on Monday, August 20, 2012, at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1711 South Main Street, Yreka. The meeting will begin at 4:00 p.m. and usually ends before 8:00 p.m. The public is invited to attend and provide comment

The Siskiyou County RAC is now accepting new project proposals for review.

The RAC is federally sanctioned by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture and was formed as a result of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000. The RAC is a local advisory committee that recommends projects to federal land managers which will benefit resources on public lands. The fifteen member group represents a cross section of county communities, industries, schools, environmentalists, and local government.
