INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP

FREMONT-WINEMA NATIONAL FOREST

The Eaglet Stewardship Integrated Resource Timber Contract is located within T.35S., R.6E., Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 33, 34, 35 and T.36 S., R.6E., Sections 3, 4, and 9; W.M. Surveyed Klamath County, Oregon. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Fremont-Winema National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1301 S. G Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97603 no later than 11:00 AM local time on or before September 6, 2012 for an estimated 50,786 Tons of White fir and Other Coniferous species Sawtimber and 284 Tons of Green Biomass. In addition, the contract area contains an unestimated volume of All Species Green Biomass Convertible Products that the Offeror may agree to remove. Also included in the contract are two Mandatory restorative service projects and nine Optional restorative service project to be completed by the Contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Offeror (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.
