

## Endangered, Threatened, and Proposed Species List – Errata

The Endangered, Threatened, and Proposed Species List (ETP) was updated in February 2012. The following corrections have been made to the list; all changes are considered routine administrative updates.

### **Update: March 13, 2012**

Species removed from RFSS list and placed on Endangered, Threatened and Proposed Species List:

#### Endangered

Sheepnose (*Plethobasus cyphus*) – HO, MT, WN

Spectaclecase (*Cumberlandia monodonta*) - MT

### **Update: May 30, 2012**

Species removed from the Endangered, Threatened and Proposed Species List for a particular unit:

#### Endangered

Sheepnose (*Plethobasus cyphus*) – remove from HO and WN

Initially, it was assumed that the Sheepnose was found within the proclamation boundary of the Hoosier National Forest. After further discussion with Brant Fischer, Indiana Nongame Aquatic Biologist, it was determined that the one living Sheepnose specimen was found outside the proclamation boundary in 1992. In the early 2000's, surveys were conducted again, with no other specimens found.

The Sheepnose has not been found within the Wayne National Forest. Occupied habitat is present only outside the proclamation boundary in the Ohio River and Muskingum River.
