ROAD CLOSURES DOWNTOWN



Downtown will remain open to pedestrians and bicycles!

Saturday – 8/18

- Main Avenue will be closed between 7th and 9th Streets beginning at 4:00 p.m. to allow the building of the Start structures (at 8th Street)

Sunday – 8/19

- The remainder of Main Avenue between 5th and 12th Streets will close (College Drive will remain open to traffic) beginning at 10:00 a.m. through Monday following the race start

Monday 8/20

- Main Avenue remains closed until approximately 2:00 p.m. to allow clean-up
- The 700-900 blocks may be closed longer while Start structures are disassembled
- Narrow Gauge will be open to thru traffic , but parking will be limited to sponsors and race staff (by permit only) and ADA (placard required)
- 2:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. (approx.) – 2nd Avenue will be closed to parking and through traffic for Pit Row and team buses
- 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. – Streets bordering Buckley Park will be closed for the Race Day Festival
- 8:00 a.m.– Opening Ceremonies begin on Main Avenue
- Entire race route will be closed at 9:45 a.m. until final chase vehicle passes

- 10:00 a.m. – Official Race Start at 8th and Main
- By 10:30 a.m. teams are expected to be out of town and clean-up will begin

ADDITIONAL LIMITED ROAD CLOSURES WILL OCCUR ALONG THE RACE ROUTE

PARK-N-RIDES


There will be four Park-n-Rides available for spectators, volunteers, downtown employees/businesses, etc. Signs will be posted along the roadway, directing drivers to the lots:

1. La Plata County Fairgrounds (approx. 850 spaces)
2. Fort Lewis College (approx. 1,500 spaces)
3. Durango Mall (approx. 500 spaces)
4. Twin Buttes (approx. 180 spaces)

All lots will be serviced by shuttles running to/from the Transit Center during the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. If you plan to be in the downtown area past 8:00 p.m. please park at the Fairgrounds as this lot is served by the Durango Trolley until 10:00 PM.



ADA Accessible Parking is available on Narrow Gauge (enter from College Drive) and in the Transit Center. Please note that you must display a handicapped placard to access this parking.

FREE Trolley and buses will run all week and weekend during the USA Pro Challenge. Go to GetAroundDurango.com for complete schedule.

Additional services during the week/weekend of the USA Pro Challenge are as follows:

Saturday, August 18th from 4:30pm – 10:30pm: Two Trolleys will run service to Fort Lewis College (FLC) for the Gala. Service will begin picking up guests at the DoubleTree Hotel (501 Camino Del Rio), travel to the Transit Center Concourse (250 W. 8th Street), to the Strater Hotel (699 Main Ave.), to the Rochester Hotel (721 East 2nd Ave.) and take guests up to the Gala at FLC. These two trolleys will run every 15 minutes until 10:30pm.

Sunday, August 19th from 3:30pm – 10:30pm: Two special service buses will run from the La Plata County Fairgrounds parking lot (2500 Main Ave.) to Buckley Park (12th Street and Main Ave.) for the downtown street festival and fireworks.

Monday, August 20th from 7:00am – 8:00pm: Buses will go from the Transit Center (250 W. 8th Street) to four satellite Park-n-Ride lots located at: the Durango Mall (800 South Camino Del Rio), Twin Buttes (20091 US 160), Fort Lewis College (1000 Rim Drive), and La Plata County Fairgrounds/DHS (2500 & 2400 Main Ave.).

*Buzz Buses will run Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights.

BIKE PARKING



Bike Parking will be available throughout the city of Durango on designated bike racks that are located on the sidewalks. Please use a designated bike rack so the flow of traffic on sidewalks is not impeded by bikes locked to trees, benches, street signs, etc.

Additional bike parking is available at:

- The Transit Center (250 W. 8th Street) approximately 75 spaces
- On 10th Street at the corner of 10th and Main (West side of Main Ave.) sponsored by Maria's Bookshop, Carver Brewing Co, and Mountain Bike Specialists – approximately 60 spaces
- On 7th Street at the corner of 7th and Main (West side of Main Ave.) sponsored by Durango Coffee Co - approximately 20 spaces
- 2nd Avenue between 10th Street and 11th Street in the parking lot south of City Hall - approximately 150 spaces (MONDAY ONLY)

**The four on-street bike corrals, normally located on Main Ave. in front of Carver Brewing Co., Maria's Bookshop, Mountain Bike Specialists, and Durango Coffee Company, will be relocated on Friday.

FREE Valet Bike Parking:

There will be two FREE Bike Valet locations Monday/Race Day:

- 700 block of Main Avenue in the Keller Williams parking lot (approx. 150 spaces)
- Corner of Main Avenue in the Model Tire parking lot (approx. 200 spaces)

The City of Durango is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen property. You must pick up your bicycle from Bike Valet Stations by 5:00 p.m. or it will be left unattended. Bikes not picked up will be subject to impound. Impounded bicycles may be claimed at the Durango Police Department (970-375-4700).



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
