FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited as described below within the Ninemile Ranger District of the Lolo National Forest. This restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and becomes effective August 23, 2012 and will remain in effect until August 31, 2012.

36 CFR 261.54 – National Forest System Roads

It is prohibited to use any motorized vehicle on the road. (36 CFR 261.54(a)).

The closure cited in this order is to provide for public safety during the installation of a culvert where East Fork Petty Creek flows under the South Fork Petty Creek Road.

Description of Closed Road:

(South Fork Petty Creek Road), National Forest System Road (NFSR) 5547, shall be closed (between milepost 0.00 to 0.25 starting at the intersection of South Fork Petty Creek Road and Petty Creek Road in Section 31, T. 13 N., R 22 W).

Exemptions:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Employees of West Construction and their subcontractors.
