

**Order No. 06-12-06**  
**Lassen National Forest**  
**Mill Fire Emergency Closure**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Almanor Ranger District of the Lassen National Forest. This Order is effective from 3:00 p.m. on August 16, 2012, until the Mill Fire has been fully suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Mill Fire Closure Area. The Mill Fire Closure Area begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 28N29 and Mill Creek, then continues west along Mill Creek to the western boundary of Black Rock Campground, then continues north along the western boundary of Black Rock Campground to its intersection with the Black Rock Campground access road, then continues east along the Black Rock Campground access road to its intersection with Forest Road No. 28N29, then continues north along Forest Road No. 28N29 to its intersection with the section line on the east side of section 13 (Township 27 North, Range 2 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian), then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of section 12, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of section 8 (Township 27 North, Range 3 East), then continues north along the section line to its intersection with the Lassen National Forest boundary, then continues east along the Lassen National Forest boundary to its intersection with Forest Road No. 28N10, then continues north along Forest Road No. 28N10 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 29N48, then continues northeast along Forest Road No. 29N48, to its intersection with the section line on the north side of section 12 (Township 28 North, Range 3 East), then continues east along the section line to its intersection with the section line on the west side of section 8 (Township 28 North, Range 4 East), then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of the same section, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of the same section, then continues south along the section line to the southeast corner of section 20, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of section 28, then continues south along the section line to the southeast corner of section 33, then continues west along the section line to the northeast corner of section 6, then continues south along the section line to the southeast corner of the same section, then continues west along the section line to the southwest corner of the same section, then continues south along the section line to its intersection with the Lassen National Forest boundary, then continues west along the National Forest boundary to the section line on the west side of section 12 (Township 27 North, Range 3 East), then continues south along the section line to its intersection with Forest Road No. 27N08, then continues west along Forest Road No. 27N08 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 28N29, then continues west along Forest Road No. 28N29, back to the starting point as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Mill Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.55(a).
3. Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
  - a. Forest Road No. 28N20.
  - b. Forest Road No. 27N08.
  - c. Forest Road No. 27N21.
  - d. Forest Road No. 27N08J.
  - e. Forest Road No. 27N21A.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the Mill Fire Closure Area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
4. Persons who reside on private land in the Mill Fire Closure Area to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.

5. Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
