**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR  
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FORESTS  
SPANISH FORK RANGER DISTRICT**

**EMERGENCY FIRE ORDER**

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the area, roads or trails as described in this Order, all within the Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect until further notice.

1. **Being in or upon the area** as described below. [ 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

Diamond Fork Road (Forest Service Road #70029) starting just beyond the entrance to Diamond Fork campground going east and north to Springville Crossing then proceeding north up the east side of section 2; then west along the northern boundaries of sections 2, 3 and 4; and south along the west boundaries, of sections 4 and 9; then west along the northern boundaries of sections 17, 18 and 13; the south along the western boundaries of sections 13, 24 and 25, then south east through section 36 to the intersections of Wanrhodes Road (Forest Service Road #70031) and Diamond Fork Road (Forest Service Road #70029). 
**PURPOSE:**

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety during fire suppression efforts of the Red Ledges Fire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7).
