August 10, 2012	D6-NP-06	<b>Goat/Ditch Fire Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> The closure area is in the vicinity of the junction of Selway River Trail 4 and Goat Ridge Trail 426. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Goat/Ditch fire area.
August 18, 2012	D6-NP-14	<b>Blacktail/Three Links Fire Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> Big Rock Trail # 693 is closed from the junction of Three Links Creek Trail #405 to the junction of Rhoda Crossing Trail # 423. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Blacktail/Three Links fire area.
August 18, 2012	D6-NP-13	<b>Vista Fire Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> Big Rock Trail #693 is closed from the junction of Selway River Trail #4 to the junction of Halfway Creek Trail #447. Shissler Peak Trail #450 is closed from the junction with Big Rock Trail #693 to Shissler Peak Lookout. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Vista fire area.
August 18, 2012	D6-NP-12	<b>Pettibone Fire Closure Area, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> The closure area begins at the junction of Bear Creek Trail #516 and Lower Pettibone Trail #649, then northeasterly along Lower Pettibone Trail #649 to the junction with Pettibone Hump Trail # 642, then southeasterly on Pettibone Hump Trail #642 to the junction with Bear Creek Trail # 516; then southwesterly along the Bear Creek Trail # 516 to the point of beginning. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Pettibone fire area.
August 20, 2012	D5-11-12	<b>Hot Springs Creek Fire Trail Closure, Red River Ranger District (208-842-2245)</b> The Hot Springs Trail #581 is closed from its junction with the Bargamin Trail #502, then follow the Hot Spring Creek Trail #581 in an east direction to its junction with the Three Prong Trail #539. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Hot Springs Creek fire area.
August 20, 2012	D6-NP-18	<b>Square Rock/Gravel Peak Fire Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> The following trails are closed: Moose Ridge Trail #562 from the junction of Martin Creek Crossing Trail #436 to the junction of Archer Trail #529. The Copper Butte Trail # 602 from the junction of Goat Creek Cutoff Trail # 548 to the junction of Moose Ridge Trail #562.	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Square Rock/Gravel Peak fire area.

August 21, 2012	D6-NP-19	<b>Moose Ridge Fire Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> The Moose Ridge Trail # 562 is closed from the junction of Spruce Creek trail # 555 to the junction with Lone Pine Trail # 437. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Moose Ridge fire area.
August 21, 2012	D6-NP-17	<b>Selway River Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> The Selway River Trail # 4 is closed from the junction of Three Links Creek Trail # 405 to the junction of Big Rock Trail # 693. It is also closed from the junction of Goat Ridge Trail # 526 to the junction of Archer Trail # 529. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Selway River area.
August 22, 2012	D6-NP-20	<b>Archer Trail Fire Trail Closure, Moose Creek Ranger District (208-926-4258)</b> Archer Trail #529 is closed from the junction of Selway River Trail #4 to Archer Saddle westerly of Archer Mountain. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety during periods of active fire in the Archer Trail Fire area.
August 25, 2012	D5-12-12	<b>Porcupine Complex Fire Road and Trail Closure, Red River Ranger District (208-842-2245)</b> Sheep Hill Trail is closed from its junction with Forest Road # 468 at the Dry Saddle Trailhead, then follow Sheep Hill trail # 575 in a southwestern direction until its junction with the Cache Creek Trail # 501. Forest Road # 468C is closed from its junction with Forest Road # 468 to its termination at Burnt Knob Lookout. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety due to fire activity and falling tree hazards.
August 24, 2012	SO-01-12	<b>Stage 1 Fire Restrictions, Nez Perce and Clearwater National Forests (on all lands including wilderness)</b> Prohibits the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire or campfire.</li> <li>2. Smoking except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material.</li> </ol> Exceptions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Persons using approved fire pans fueled with charcoal briquettes in designated recreation sites on the Salmon River corridor.</li> <li>2. Persons using fully enclosed wood burning stoves equipped with a chimney that is at least five (5) in length with a spark-arresting screen consisting of ¼ inch mesh</li> </ol>	Prevent human-caused fires during a period of very high fire danger.

Fires fueled solely by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels may be used on National Forest System Lands during State 1 fire restrictions. 4. Campfires in campfire rings that are concrete, metal culvert rings, or iron type rings will be allowed at developed sites. 5. All lands within a city boundary within the Forest Boundaries.	
August 30, 2012	D6-CLW-16	<b>Powell Complex Fire Closure, Powell Ranger District (208-942-3113)</b> This closure includes the area south of private lands and south of the Lochsa River that lie east of the Mocus Pack Bridge. This closure also encompasses areas outlined in rescinded Orders D6-CLW-04, 08, and 14. <b>See order for exact location.</b>	Provide for public safety because of wildfire activity in the area.
August 30, 2012	D5-15-12NP	<b>McGuire Complex Fire Area, Trail and Road Closure, Red River Ranger District (208-842-2245)</b> This closure includes the area west of Road #222 and Burpee Road from the Wheeler Road Junction to Halfway and east of the Gospel Hump Wilderness from Halfway to the northeast corner of the Wilderness back to Road #222 at Wheeler Road. Forest Road # 222 is to remain open. <b>See order for exact location.</b> Please note: Road #233 is closed at the junction of Highway 14 by the Idaho County Sheriff's Department.	Provide for public safety because of wildfire activity in the area.
