

**NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE**

**INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP**

**FREMONT-WINEMA NATIONAL FOREST**

The advertisement published on August 22, 2012 in the Herald and News for the Cord Stewardship Integrated Resource Timber Contract listed two mandatory stewardship projects to be completed by the Contractor. The contract now lists three mandatory stewardship projects, moving acres from Project 1 to Project 3. The prospectus, bid form, amendment to the bid form, sample contract, and Contract Area Map have been modified to reflect the change in the number of stewardship projects. The three mandatory stewardship projects consist of cut, skid, and deck of 4.0 – 6.9 inch DBH material. Please see the sample contract for the details on each stewardship project.

The Contract Area Map incorrectly stated that skidtrails must be scarified. The Contract Area Map now states that only landings and temporary roads must be scarified to a depth of eight (8) inches.

The Forest Service will still receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at Fremont-Winema National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1301 South G Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630 no later than 11:00 AM local time on or before September 21, 2012.
