Dear Prospective Bidder:

The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at Fremont-Winema National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1301 South G Street, Lakeview, OR 97630 no later than 11:00 a.m. local time on or before September 21, 2012 for the Cord Stewardship Contract. This contract is located in Sections 12, and 13, T.34S., R.11E.; Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34, T.34S., R.12E.; Section 3, T.35S., R.12E.; Surveyed, WM, Klamath County, Oregon. Contract Form FS-2400-13 will be used. The termination date for this contract is October 31, 2016.

The Forest Service will hold a pre-bid conference and site visit of the contract area on Wednesday, August 29, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Bly Ranger District office located in Bly, Oregon. The morning will start with a discussion of the contract, the Best Value award process, and requirements for both pricing and the technical proposal. Afterwards, we will visit specific locations in the contract area to explain and review the Stewardship Projects and any additional information needs. Anyone planning to attend should come prepared to travel to the contract area. Transportation will not be provided.

This stewardship contract includes the removal of timber and the completion of two mandatory stewardship projects meant to improve ecological conditions within the Fremont-Winema National Forest. The contractor will earn stewardship credits equal to the value of stewardship work completed and accepted that will offset an equal amount of stumpage required to be paid by the contractor. The mandatory projects are shown below.

The minimum acceptable total bid for mandatory timber cutting units \$522,768.12.

A bid guarantee is not required.

Bidders are required to submit a Bid Price/Best Value proposal for this contract. Contract award will be based on a determination of which proposal constitutes the best value to the Government. Proposals will be submitted in two parts and will include a Technical and a Price Proposal. Details on what to include in the proposals are stated in the Bid Form. Award will be made to the bidder whose offer is both technically acceptable and whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Government may, when in its interest, reject any or all offers or waive any informality in bids received. A written award mailed, or otherwise furnished to the successful Bidder, shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.
