This cost share agreement between Forest Service, (USDA-FS) and the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) was prepared under the following guidelines:

1. In accordance with the following Master Agreements:
 - a. Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the USDI Bureau of Land Management (BLM), USDI National Park Service (NPS) USDA National Forest Service (USFS), and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE)
2. All costs originating from orders placed by and for the incident that can be reasonably obtained and estimated for the cost share period will be included in this agreement and will be the fiscal responsibility of the agency as designated by the ICs/ARs' mutual agreement.
3. Costs for non-expendable property purchases by each agency will be charged direct to that agency and will not be shared.
4. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged in Joint fire suppression activities will not be included as part of this cost agreement
5. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
6. Responsibility for tort claim costs or compensation for injury costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside of this agreement.
7. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
8. Costs for repair of agency owned equipment is the responsibility of the owning agency and will not be part of this agreement.
9. USFS agrees to pay for all Fixed wing Air Costs

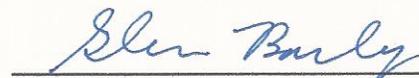
19. USFS agrees to pay all costs associated with all Federal Overhead used on this incident.

21. Cal Fire agrees to pay for all costs associated with all Cal Fire and Los Angeles County Fire overhead authorized by the Cal Fire Agency Representative to be used on this incident.
22. Cal Fire agrees to pay for all costs associated with meals provided by Los Angeles County Fire to fire personnel at the incident. This includes personnel and equipment used to prepare and deliver the meals as well as the cost of the food.
23. The following resources responded through local agreement with the Los Angeles County Fire Department and are not to be reimbursed by either Cal Fire or USFS:
 - A-9 LFD Fire 1
 - E-3 KRN Engine 356
 - E-6 LFD Dozer 11
24. The following Supplies were ordered by USFS and will be Paid by USFS:
 - S-2 Hand wash units
 - S-3 Toilets
 - S-4 ADA Toilet
 - S-5 Crew Lodging
25. Within 365 days the parties to this agreement will meet to determine the total actual costs of each agency. The Agency whose total actual costs exceed their agreed upon costs will bill the other agency. The billing, when paid, will result in each agency sharing overall incident costs as herein agreed.

This agreement is our best judgments of agency cost responsibilities.
