LOCAL GOVERNMENT FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

October 31, 2007

On 10/21/07 a wildland fire ignited in State Responsibility Area (SRA) and quickly burned into and through 2 sections of Local Responsibility Area (LRA) land (as shown in the attached map). The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA), as lead Fire Agency in that area and as a Contract County for the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) responded to this incident with a large number of land and air resources to fight the fire in both LRA and SRA areas.

In accordance with the 2007 Southern California Fire Siege Letter of Management Direction dated October 26, 2007, the following agreement has been made between CAL FIRE and OCFA concerning billing of resources for the LRA portion of the Santiago Incident.

- All OCFA Air Resources used during the entire incident will be 100% charged to CAL FIRE and billed through normal billing procedures.
- All OCFA dozers, hand crews, and overhead used during the entire incident will be 100% charged to CAL FIRE and billed through normal billing procedures.
- The following local government strike teams, made up of local resources other than OCFA, will be billed through OES using the CFAA process and charged to the State:




- All OCFA engines, patrols and water tenders on the incident will be 100% the responsibility of OCFA from the beginning of the incident on 10/21/07 to 0800 on 10/22/07. As such, these resources and associated support costs will be paid directly by OCFA and will not be billed to CAL FIRE.
- All OCFA engines, patrols and water tenders on the incident from 0800 hrs. on 10/22/07 to the end of the incident will be charged to CAL FIRE and billed through normal billing procedures.
- All support costs associated with the incident provided from OCFA headquarters or from any OCFA fire stations will be the responsibility of OCFA from the start of the incident to 0800 hrs. on 10/22/07. After that time, only fuel provided from the OCFA headquarters will be considered OCFA responsibility. All other support items (fuel, food, water, misc. supplies) from OCFA fire stations directly attributed to the incident may be charged back to CAL FIRE.

- All support cost associated with the Incident Base located at Irvine Park and all purchases made in support of that base will be 100% billable to CAL FIRE through normal billing procedures.
- Any Non Expendable property (printers, fax machines, etc.) purchased with OCFA funds will not be billable to CAL FIRE and will be retained by OCFA at the close of the incident.

The above information is based on information and analysis of resources as is currently known and represents what we believe is a fair division of responsibility for the LRA portion of the Santiago incident.
