**ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
RESTRICTING USE OF FIRES, TO WIT:**

MT. BAKER-SNOQUALMIE NATIONAL FOREST - WASHINGTON

Under the authority of the Act of Congress dated June 4, 1897, as amended (16 U.S.C. 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth as 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B [36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)], the following acts and omissions are prohibited in the Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest, State of Washington:

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, briquette fire, or stove fire; except a portable stove or lantern using gas, jellied petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel outside of developed recreation sites listed in Exhibit A. **36 CFR 261.52(a)**
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material. **36 CFR 261.52(d)**

THESE RESTRICTION(S) ARE NECESSARY TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY AND PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THESE PROHIBITION(S) WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL SPECIFICALLY WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to the provisions of 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a valid permit signed by the District Ranger or Forest Supervisor in their possession that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission [36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)]; and,
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty [36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)];

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
