In Dianne Stearns' Beginning/ Intermediate Landscape in Graphite workshop, you will learn to break the landscape down into simple shapes, textures and values. Start in classroom, then go on the Stanislaus National Forest to picturesque sites selected by the artist.

Some topics include: Learning to understand and manipulate the value scale; Textures that describe the tactile characteristics of things we see in a landscape. When the landscape is broken down into SHAPE, TEXTURE, and VALUE, any subject becomes approachable. After lunch you will choose a landscape vignette and practice the new skills you've learned.



Dianne Stearns, a California Watercolorist & Engraver, is best known for her vibrantly colored florals, high design graphics, and inspired animal paintings. Dianne is also well known for her glass engraving, and her approachable teaching style. Dianne's artwork has garnered ribbons in numerous juried shows and she has been honored by several one and two woman shows.
