ROSE CREEK CAMP GROUND PUBLIC SAFETY CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the areas and roads described in this order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “restricted area”), all within the Pleasant Valley Ranger District, of the Tonto National Forest, Gila County, Arizona:

1. Going into or being upon the Rose Creek Campground. 36 CFR 261.53e
2. Being on Forest Roads 152 and 1687. 36 CFR 261.54e

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Residents, owners or lessees of land within the restricted area and holders of Forest Service special use authorizations for uses of land within the restricted area may use Forest System Road (all roads or specific roads?) for ingress and egress to and from their property or land they are using under permit.

AREA DESCRIBED

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands, roads and trails within the exterior boundaries as described as follows.

All lands encompassed by the Rose Creek Campground, including Forest Roads 152 and 1687.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to provide for the public’s health and safety and to protect National Forest System lands, resources and facilities during the current monsoon season and consequent flooding.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. Prohibitions contained in this Order become effective immediately upon execution of the Order and will remain in effect until October 31, 2012, unless terminated sooner.
2. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
