Group Rates (Excludes Wild Tour):

- 16 years and older - \$10.00
- 6-15 years - \$6.00
- Under 6 years - \$1.00
- School Group Student Rate 6-15 years - \$4.00
- Payments: Cash, US Travelers Checks, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, American Express
- Available throughout the year
- Each group member receives a discount of the standard tour

Group Criteria:

- Any group of 15 or more persons at least 6 years old
- Reservations must be made at least one day in advance
- One discount rate for members of any one group
- Groups of children must have an adult sponsor
- One person designated as responsible for purchasing tickets for the entire group in one lump sum
- Groups larger than 30 people will be scheduled for successive tours when possible
- Educational groups must specify the group's name when making reservations
- Tickets must be picked up 30 minutes before tour time

The 1-hour Dripstone Trail Tour is open year round (closed on Mondays and Tuesdays, November through March, and Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Days). The 1 ½-hour Discovery Trail Tour is open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Group discounts are not available for the Wild Cave Tour. Rates and schedules are subject to change. Contact us for current information.
