


Hunting in the Boggy - Glade Travel Area



The Boggy-Glade area encompasses portions of Hunt Unit 711 and a small part of Hunt Unit 71.

No Forest Service roads have been closed so access will be very similar to last year.

There are 3 areas where driving off of the numbered roads is currently not allowed; 1) the area around Benchmark, Glade and Thomas Mountains; 2) The area around Lake McPhee; 3) the area north east of the Cottonwood Road. These areas are marked with an A, or B on the older versions of our Forest Visitor Map. Motorized off-road game retrieval is not allowed in these areas.

The rest of the Boggy-Glade Travel Management area is open to driving both on and off of the numbered roads. This means you can use an ATV or vehicle to retrieve game. Keep in mind that making deep ruts, tearing up meadows, or 'mud bogging' in streams is illegal resource damage so be considerate of the land.

As always, keep a clean camp, extinguish campfires and enjoy your time on the National Forest.
