

AREA CLOSURE for PUBLIC SAFETY

PYRAMID FIRE

FOREST SERVICE DEVELOPMENT ROADS, TRAILS, AND AREA CLOSURE

**OKANOGAN-WENATCHEE NATIONAL
ENTIAT RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all portions of National Forest System (NFS) Land shown on the attached map and described below, within the Okanogan - Wenatchee National Forest. This closure order is needed to provide for public health and safety, and the protection of Forest Resources in the area which was damaged by Pyramid Fire 2012.

1. Being on a road, trail, or other developed sites within in the Closure Areas. For the purposes of this order, this restriction applies to use and travel by any means on Forest Service lands, as described above (36 CFR 261.54 (e)).

Entiat Ranger District: All areas listed.

Area Closure -Pyramid Fire Area

- Closure begins at Entiat River Rd 51/North Fork Entiat Rd 5606, (T29N-R18E, Sec. 27), and follows the 5606 Rd, keeping road closed.
- Closure continues at end of Rd 5606 and follows the bottom of the Crow Creek drainage directly to Entiat District boundary, (T29N-R19E, Sec. 7).
- Closure then follows District boundary north/northwest until jct. with Wilderness boundary, (TN30-R17E, Sec. 25).
- Closure then follows Wilderness boundary south/southwest to just shy of jct. with Trail #1434, (T30N-R18E, Sec. 19).
- Closure then follows the #1434 Trail on its E and NE side, allowing Trail #1434 to remain open, and continuing to the Trailhead and jct. with Rd #5608, (T29N-R18E, Sec. 10).
- Closure then follows Rd #5608 on its E and SE side, allowing Rd #5608 to remain open, and continues to the jct. with the 5100 Rd, (T29N-R18E, Sec. 22).

- Closure then parallels Rd 5100 on the NE, allowing Rd 5100 to remain open to jct. with Rd 5606 (T29N-R18E, Sec. 27).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following exceptions may apply:

1. Any federal, state, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Person with a permit, issued by the Forest Supervisor or District Ranger, specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act as specified in this order.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
