<p>Wood Cutting is <b>prohibited</b> within the timber sale areas along the following road systems:</p> <p><b>Hood River</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bull Bronco Sale: 16 Road.</b> (Redhill Road) Skyline, Helicopter and ground based</li> <li>• <b>Ashes-Caldera Sale: 16 road.</b> Possible delays and closures due to road reconstruction</li> <li>• <b>Basalt Sale: 1610 road.</b> Possible delays and closures due to road reconstruction</li> <li>• <b>Mule Sale: 1340 road.</b> Possible delays and closures along 1340 road. Helicopter and skyline logging. Some helicopter logging above the 18 road near Ladd Creek</li> <li>• <b>Raft Sale: 2610, 4310, 2130, 2120, 4330 roads.</b> Logging activity</li> </ul>	<p><b>Areas Open</b></p> <p><b>Eastside</b></p> <p><b>Blow down:</b> Lots of blow down on Eastside. Get the easy stuff and help us clear the roads. Refer to the Firewood map of where and where not to cut.</p> <p><b>July 16<sup>th</sup> you can cut 100 feet each side of road in the “hatched mark” areas shown on eastside map.</b> This includes roads surrounding The Dalles Watershed; 1700, 1720, 4410 and 44 road even though they are greyed out. The 4860.140 (Badger Lake road is included)</p> <p><b>Barlow District (South) The 4850, 4860, 4870, 4880, 4881, and others off of 48 road system are now open that were previously closed due to Timber sale activity.</b></p> <p><b>The 1711 road system was previously closed and is now open.</b></p>
