**ORDER NO. 06-03-03-12-04**

**SPECIAL AREA CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order and depicted on Exhibit A, within and/or administered by the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Mount Adams Ranger District, until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the area affected by the Cascade Creek Fire (36 CFR 261.53(e))

**AREA DESCRIPTION:**

The following description serves as the exterior boundary and closes all lands encompassed within it as depicted in attached Exhibit A:

Travel on roads and trails that are part of the exterior boundary is permitted.


From a point of beginning, at the intersection of Wicky Creek Trail #38 and National Forest System (NFS) Road 8040020, in the S.E. corner of Section 22, T7N, R10E, travel E. on NFS Road 8040020 about 2 miles to the intersection of NFS Road 8020, then E. on NFS Road 8020 about a half-mile to the intersection of NFS Road 8225150, then N.E. along NFS Road 8225150 to Snipes Mtn. trail #11, follow trail N. about 2 ½ miles to the intersection of Pineway trail #71, in the S.E. corner of Section 6, T7N, R11E, travel due W. about ½ mile to the Western edge of a geographical feature known as the A.G. Aiken lava flow, then N. along the W. edge of the lava flow about 2 miles to the intersection of Round-The-Mtn. Trail #9 at approximately 6400 foot elevation, then N.N.W. about 1 mile to a feature know as South Butte at an elevation of 7800 feet, follow that elevation N.W. along the South and West slopes of Mt. Adams to S.E. corner of Section 35, T9N, R10E, travel W. about 2 miles downslope to the intersection of Pacific Crest Trail #2000 and Riley Trail #64, follow Riley Trail #64 W. about 3 miles to its intersection with Riley South Trail #64a and the junction of the Mt Adams Wilderness boundary, continue S. along the Wilderness boundary about 4 miles to the intersection of Sections 24,25/ PB37,38 T8N, 9E, follow Wilderness boundary E. about ½ mile along the N. boundary of Section 30, T8N,10E, then travel due S. about ¼ mile to NFS Road 8031070, follow NFS Road 8031070 S. about 3 ½ miles to the intersection of NFS Road 8031, travel E. on NFS Road 8031 1 ½ miles to the intersection of NFS Road 8031050, then N.E. along NFS 8031050 1 ½ miles to the intersection of NFS Road 8031020, travel S.E. on NFS Road 8031020 about 2 ½ miles to the intersection of NFS Road 8031027, in the S.W. quarter of Section 15, T7N, R10E, travel ¼ mile due E. to NFS Road 8040, follow NFS Road 8040 S. about ½ mile to intersection of Morrison Creek Trail #39, follow Trail #39 E. 100 feet to intersection of Wicky Trail #38, then S. on Trail #38 ½ mile to point of beginning.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
