


## Campfire Permits

Campfire Permits are required year-round for the use of campfires, charcoal barbeques, gas stoves and lanterns outside of developed recreation areas. Permits are available free of charge and can be obtained by visiting any Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management or California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection office.



Developed recreation areas (such as designated campgrounds and picnic areas) tend to be well-marked and usually include a metal fire ring, a picnic table and a parking area. When in doubt, GET A PERMIT!
