

Off-Highway Vehicle Use

When touring the forest in a vehicle (i.e. car, truck, SUV, quad, motorcycle, etc.) stay in designated areas and on established roads and trails. Be careful, and **DON'T EXPOSE YOUR VEHICLE'S HOT PARTS TO DRY VEGETATION**. Even when travelling in designated areas, narrow trails and two-tracks may get brushy and dangerous. Catalytic converters, hot exhaust pipes, etc., can start wildfires if they come in contact with dry vegetation. Be careful when you explore and continually monitor your gauges and temperature.
