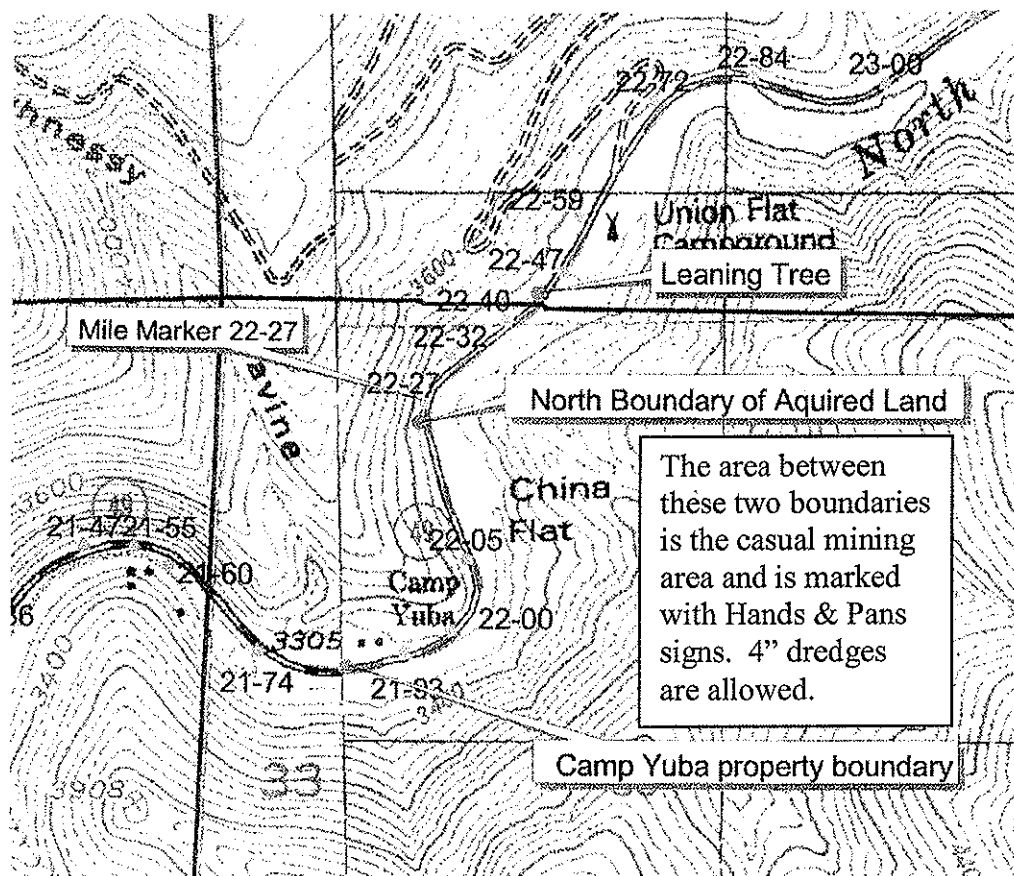


Panning and Dredging Union Flat

Yuba River Ranger District – Tahoe National Forest

This map is provided to show areas where mining claims cannot be located and where the Forest Service permits casual mining activities, as long as they do not conflict with other recreational uses of the area.

The area south of section 28 to the private land at Camp Yuba is still open to casual mining. The mineral rights on those National Forest System lands in Section 33 were donated and are not subject to mineral location.



- Maximum dredge size: 4 inches
- Dredging season: June 1 to October 15
- 14 Day Limit: All recreational mining activity is limited to 14 days per year in the Union Flat recreation area.
- Camping is permitted in campgrounds only.
- Dredging permit required for each nozzle operator.
