

Tanner Creek Trail #431



Recreation Opportunity Guide

Distance..... 0.5 miles (one way)
Elevation..... 1200-1320 feet
Snow Free May to October



Trail Highlights: This trail is in the Mark O. Hatfield Wilderness. This is a lightly used trail in a remote part of the Mark O. Hatfield Wilderness Area.

Trail Description: This trail begins at the end of Tanner Creek Road (closed Forest Road 8400-777) (1,200') and ends at Moffett Creek Trail #430 (1,320'). From Tanner Creek Road, this trail enters the Mark O. Hatfield Wilderness and heads south through the Tanner Creek valley. After 0.1 mile the trail reaches the Tanner Cutoff Trail #448 (#448 takes you east to Tanner Butte Trail #401). The trail continues straight (south) for 0.4 mile and crosses several small streams before reaching the end of the trail at Moffett Creek Trail #430.

Regulations & Leave No Trace Information:

- Group size is limited to 12. Stock are counted in the group size. For example, 3 people riding their own horse plus a spare horse in the group for packing would make a group of 7.

Leave No Trace

- Plan Ahead and Prepare: Prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies.
- Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces: Use established trails and campsites.
- Dispose of Waste Properly: Pack out all trash, leftover food and litter.
- Leave What You Find: Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species.
- Minimize Campfire Impacts: Use established fire rings & keep fires small.
- Respect Wildlife: Control pets at all times.
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors: Avoid loud voices and noises.


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Directions to Trailhead: Eastbound US Hwy 1-84: Travel east on US Hwy 84 to Exit #40, signed for Bonneville Dam. Follow signs to the Historic Columbia River Highway State Trail (0.5 mile). Park in the large parking lot (day passes required and overnight parking is permitted, but no camping). Follow Tanner Creek Road (closed Forest Road 8400-777) 4.5 miles to Tanner Creek Trail #431.

Westbound US Hwy 1-84: Travel west on US Hwy 84 to Exit #40. Follow signs to the Historic Columbia River Highway State Trail (0.5 mile). Park in the large parking lot (day passes required and overnight parking is permitted, but no camping). Follow Tanner Creek Road (closed Forest Road 8400-777) 4.5 miles to Tanner Creek Trail #431.
