

Tygh Creek Trail #460



Recreation Opportunity Guide

Distance..... 7.5 miles (one way)
Elevation..... 2550-5450 feet
Snow Free June to October



Trail Highlights: This little used trail runs through the southwestern portion of the Badger Creek Wilderness Area. There are backpacking and loop options available from this trail. This is a nice trail for solitude.

Trail Description: This trail begins at Forest Road 27 and ends at Road 2730-200(Flag Pt. Road). Beginning at Forest Road 27 (2,550') the trail heads northwest following Tygh Creek for 0.4 mile (2,640'). The trail heads north, away from the creek, then climbs northwest and after 0.8 mile, passes Pen Point to the north (3,880'). Leaving Pen Point the trail climbs a steeper grade to the junction with Jordan Cutoff Trail #462 (4,320'). Stay left on #460 heading west and continue 3.2 miles further to the trails end at the junction with the west end of Little Badger Trail #469 at FS rd. 2730-200 Flag Point Rd. (5,450').

Regulations & Leave No Trace Information:

- Group size is limited to 12. Stock are counted in the group size. For example, 3 people riding their own horse plus a spare horse in the group for packing would make a group of 7.

Leave No Trace

- Plan Ahead and Prepare: Prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies.
- Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces: Use established trails and campsites.
- Dispose of Waste Properly: Pack out all trash, leftover food and litter.
- Leave What You Find: Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species.
- Minimize Campfire Impacts: Use established fire rings & keep fires small.
- Respect Wildlife: Control pets at all times.
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors: Avoid loud voices and noises.




Directions to Trailhead: From Dufur, travel south on US Hwy 197 for 13.8 miles to Shadybrook Road at Tygh Valley. Turn right onto Shadybrook and travel 1.1 miles to Fairgrounds Road. Travel 0.6 mile on Fairgrounds Road to Badger Creek Road. Travel 6.5 miles and turn right onto Forest Road 27. Travel 2.8 miles on Forest Road 27 to the small parking area on the left (west) side of the road, just north of Tygh Creek. For access to the west end of this trail, see directions to #469 Little Badger Trail.
