PLEASANT HILL RANGER DISTRICT
Clarksville, AR

Color (or Expectation):	Still some nice color but barely past peak.
Recommended Viewing Routes:	Hwy 21 from Clarksville to Hwy 412 around Berryville Hwy 7 from Russellville to Missouri Hwy 16 from Clinton to Fayetteville
Estimated Peak Period:	A little past peak in the upper elevations but in the lower elevations peak is about 10 days away.
Temperature:	Upper 50s daytime lower 30s nighttime.
Remarks:	Still nice colors. Sweetgums, Hickories and Oaks are just now starting to change colors.

BIG PINEY RANGER DISTRICT
Jasper & Hector, AR

Color (or Expectation):	Colors starting to change in lower part the district (Hector). The leaves up North (Jasper) are beginning to fall. Maples and Sweetgums are turning beautiful, and the Oaks are starting to change. The Black Gum, Sassafras and Hickory are all starting to change colors also.
Recommended Viewing Routes:	Hwy 7 from Russellville to Jasper Hwy 27 North of Hector Hwy 123 Hwy 74
Estimated Peak Period:	October 30 th – November 15 th
Temperature:	During the Day: 60s to 70s At Night: 40s to 50s
Remarks:	If you want to see the colors, you need to get out within the next couple of weeks.
