EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-03-12-18
CLOSED CAMPING AREAS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and 261.53(e) and 261.55(a), and because of the risk of falling trees and limbs resulting from recent tree mortality caused by extreme drought, stresses to live trees due to recent rainfall, and strong winds, I am closing the following areas:

- AREAS CLOSED:** Camping areas located in the **DAVY CROCKETT NATIONAL FOREST** within Houston County, Texas, which are further described in the prohibited acts below and on the attached map.
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Closure Order is effective September 26, 2012 until March 1, 2013, or until rescinded.
- PROHIBITED ACTS:** **No person may enter, go into or be upon or within** the *White Rock Hunter Camp off Forest Service Road (FSR) 514/514D and Ratcliff Lake Camping Area off State Highway 7*. A map showing the areas where the prohibitions are applicable is attached.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (3) Emergency crews who are repairing or restoring utility services; and
- (4) Persons with permission from a forest officer.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
