

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTION
Roosevelt National Forest – Boulder Ranger District

Dusk to Dawn Closure to Recreational Shooting -
Former Nederland Dumpsite and Lefthand Canyon Off-Highway-Vehicle Area

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within the former Nederland Dumpsite and Lefthand Canyon Off-Highway-Vehicle Area of the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, Boulder County, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area. This Order is necessary to ensure public safety.

The Restricted Area is defined as National Forest System Lands in the former Nederland Dumpsite area as located in T. 1S, R. 72 W, section 19 and National Forest System lands within the Lefthand Canyon Off-Highway-Vehicle Area located in T. 2N, R. 71 W, sections 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 6th Principal Meridian, as depicted on the attached maps, hereby included in this Order as Exhibits A and B.

PROHIBITED ACT:

Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise.
36 C.F.R. §261.58 (m).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. §Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Persons with a USDA Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Any Federal, State or local officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

Any person possessing a valid Colorado hunting license lawfully involved in hunting and harvesting game.

Any person using a paintball gun.

This Order goes into effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until December 31, 2013, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of this regulation is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 18, U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571.
